GENERAL INFORMATION

MODULATE™ is an effective, easy to use, adjuvant for deposition improvement and drift retardation in spraying operations. MODULATE™ is compatible with most water soluble and wettable powder pesticides, desiccants, and cotton defoliants when applied by aerial or standard ground application. MODULATE™ when used in accordance with sound agricultural practices is in compliance with Federal Food and Drug Administration regulations governing the cropland use of adjuvants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

REFER TO PESTICIDE LABEL FOR SPECIFIC CROP USE AND APPLICATION RATES. Fill the spray tank half to three quarters full, add pesticide components, and provide good agitation. Shake MODULATE™ well before use. Select proper dosage from Dosage Chart (generally 1-8 oz.) and slowly add MODULATE™. If additional surfactants or spray adjuvants are to be used, they should be added after MODULATE™. Continue agitation until tank is full. Prior to use, read and follow all directions on this label and on the label of the pesticide(s) being used. The pesticide(s) manufacturer's label for specific

usages and restrictions have precedence over DIRECTIONS FOR USE referred to on this label. NOT FOR AQUATIC USE IN WASHINGTON STATE.

APPLICATION RATES

Spray Application	MODULATE™ per 100 gallons
Cone or Raindrop nozzles	1 - 3 fluid ounces
Flat Fan or Flood nozzles	1 - 5 fluid ounces
Off Center nozzles	2 - 6 fluid ounces
Spray Gun	5 - 8 fluid ounces

NOTE: The degree of drift hazard varies with the type of pesticide, application conditions, and vegetation near the sprayed area. Remember, pesticide drift is no accident. Common sense and sound application technology must be followed when spraying pesticides. MODULATE™ will retard, but not totally eliminate drift.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store product in original container and keep container tightly closed when not in use. Take care to prevent water from being introduced to the contents of this container. Keep away from sparks, flame, static electricity or other ignition sources. Shake well before use and keep from freezing.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Triple rinse empty container and offer for recycling or dispose of in an approved sanitary landfill.
