The blue color makes the application highly visible on many natural surfaces.

DIRECTIONS

SPRAY MARK application rates will vary depending on the quality and color of the spray area. For optimal rate application, experiment with the volume of spray solution and rate of SPRAY MARK to find a rate that is functional and economical.

USE RATES

RECOMMENDED RATES: 8-32 ounces per 100 gallons of spray solution treated. For smaller spray applications using backpacks and small sprayers, use 2/3 - 2 ounces per 3 gallons.

STORAGE

Store in a cool well-ventilated place. Keep in original container tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. Do not store with food, feed, or other material to be used or consumed by humans or animals. Do not contaminate water supplies.

Do not allow water to be introduced into the product in this container. Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not store with oxidizing agents or ammonium nitrate.

DISPOSAL

Product: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Dispose of contents in container to an approved waste disposal facility in accordance with all local /regional/national/international regulations.
