PRINCIPAL FUNCTIONING AGENTS:

Anionic cleaning agents, ammonia and other sequestering and chelating agents All ingredients are exempt from tolerance under 40 CFR 180.

IF INHALED: If breathing is difficult, remove person to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, and then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TANK CLEANER is a concentrated tank cleaner that dissolves pesticide residues in water faster and more completely for easier removal. TANK CLEANER reduces the residues caused by hard water.

TANK CLEANER works with most active ingredients and other tank mix partners. TANK CLEANER increases tank pH, which aids in the removal of acid residues. These acid residues, if carried-over to the next tank mix, may cause harm to non-target species.

DIRECTIONS AND USE RATES

SMALL TANK AND BACK-PACK SPRAYERS: Fill tank partially with water. Add about one ounce of TANK CLEANER per gallon of water, agitate thoroughly, drain and follow with clean water rinse. Several rinses may be necessary for thorough cleaning.

LARGE TANKS AND SPRAYERS: Use TANK CLEANER at a dilution rates up to 1:400 or approximately one quart per 100 gallons. This rate may be increased for more difficult-to-remove residues. Tailor the use rate to the difficulty of the residue.

Add rinse water then tank cleaner. Circulate the tank cleaner mixture for 10 to 15 minutes. Also, push TANK CLEANER through booms, hoses, nozzles and all wetted parts of the equipment for several minutes. After cleaning, completely flush out the product with a thorough rinse. Follow with more rinses, if necessary. Make sure all parts are rinsed with water before moving on to the next spray tank mix. Use multiple rinses on hard-to-remove pesticides such as dicamba or 2,4-D.

HARD TO CLEAN RESIDUES AND RINSATE TESTING:

Using this product or other tank cleaners does not ensure elimination of all residues. Some pesticides, such as 2,4-D and dicamba, may leave persistent or hardto-remove residues which could injure certain crops, if not removed completely. Many conditions effect the consistency of TANK CLEANER (i.e., water quality, use of cleaning equipment, quantity and type of residue, age and condition of spray tank, spray lines, nozzles etc.). In order to guarantee that all residues have been removed, apply a portion of the clean rinsate to sensitive plants (tomato, cotton, ornamentals, etc.) and after adequate time, observe for signs of stress or injury. If injure does occur, repeat cleaning process and retest as above.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store locked up. Store in a cool wellventilated place. Keep in original container tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. Do not store with food, feed, or other material to be used or consumed by humans or animals. Do not contaminate water supplies.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Dispose of contents / container to an approved waste disposal facility in accordance with all federal, state and local regulations. Triple rinse (or equivalent) adding rinse water to application tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by local regulations.
