15. INDIRECT LIQUID PRODUCTS

Unless specific rules and regulations published in tariffs making reference to this item provide otherwise, the indirect liquid products of oil or gas wells, uncontaminated by chemicals or other material foreign to natural production from oil or gas fields, will be accepted and transported only if:

▲ (C) The Reid vapor pressure of the indirect products does not exceed 12 pounds per square inch absolute (psia), and the Reid vapor pressure of the resulting mixture of crude petroleum and indirect liquid products does not exceed 9.5 psia; except that Company reserves the right to limit the Reid vapor pressure of indirect products or mixtures of crude petroleum and indirect products to such lower levels as may be required by Company's facilities and operating conditions;
